Lecture by Mr. Dirk HEBECKER, UNHCR Representative in Japan



Mr. Dirk Hebecker joined the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees (UNHCR) in 1993 as Associate Repatriation Officer in Hanoi, Vietnam, after working for the Ministry of Foreign Affairs in Germany and the German Embassy in Hanoi.

Since then he has been working for over 20 years in humanitarian affairs in UNHCR's various functions in countries such as Georgia, Myanmar, Sri Lanka, and Bangladesh as well as UNHCR's Headquarters in Geneva. He was also seconded to the Office of the High Commissioner for Human Rights (OHCHR) in the Russian Federation. Prior to his assignment as Representative in Japan, he was Representative of UNHCR in Korea. Mr. Hebecker majored in international relations and South-East Asia studies and is fluent in English, French, Russian and Vietnamese.
