

HOW TO GET TO BURGOS FROM MADRID

LOCATION



BY PLANE

- Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas International Airport (a 237 Km. from Burgos)

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION FROM ADOLFO SUAREZ MADRID-BARAJAS AIRPORT TO MADRID



Underground

Metro line 8 runs from Nuevos Ministerios station in central Madrid to all the airport terminals in approximately 12-15 minutes.

Stops at the airport:

- T4 Airport. Terminal T4. Floor -1
- T1, T2, T3 Airport. Terminal 2. Floor 1

Tariffs: One-way ticket: €4.5 (includes the €3* airport supplement).

You can buy tickets at the ticket counters and ticket machines in the lobby of any Metro station.

**Users of travel passes or tourist passes do not need to pay this supplement.*

Opening hours: From 6:05 to 2:00.



Bus

Several bus lines run from the airport to central Madrid, nearby towns and large cities in the rest of Spain.

Estimated travel time: 40 minutes in normal traffic conditions

Route 200: Avenida de América-Airport

City **bus route 200** runs from terminals T1, T2, T3 and T4 of Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas airport to the **Avenida de América** Transport Hub, where there are connections to several city and intercity bus routes and the Madrid Metro system.

Stops at the airport

- Terminal T4. Floor 0. Arrivals
- Terminal T1. Floor 0. Arrivals
- Terminal T1. Floor 1. Departures
- Terminal T2. Floor 0. Arrivals
- Terminal T2. Floor 2. Departures

Tariffs: A single ticket costs **€1.50 -2 €** and is valid for one journey. You can only buy this on board the bus.

There are two types of metrobus pass:

- Valid for 10 Metro trips in zone A, in EMT city buses (except the Línea Exprés to and from the airport) and Metro Ligero line 1: **€12,20.**
- Valid for 10 Metro trips and EMT city bus trips (except Línea Exprés) with a single transfer from EMT to EMT in a maximum of 60 minutes from the first validation: **€18,30.**

You can buy the metrobus pass at the ticket counters or the ticket machines in the lobby of any Metro station, and in tobacconists and authorised news-stands in Madrid.

Opening hours:From 5:00 to 23:30.

Runs every 12 to 15 minutes at peak times.

Madrid-Burgos Bus

Madrid and Burgos are very well connected by bus by the company ALSA, located on 1st Floor of the Interchanger connecting different long distances buses and trains at América Avenue (subway stop "Avenida de América" in lines 4, 6 and 9).
